### Position Summary

The Water Polo Coach will assist with the supervision, mentoring and training of Pymble Ladies' College students at weekly training sessions and weekend games.

### Role Responsibilities

#### 1. Coaching

- 1.6 Dedication to player development at all levels.
- 1.7 Establish and be aware of individual and team goals for players and help provide advice to help them attain these goals.
